Project Overview

LGL's Bonikro operation is located in the central southern portion of Côte d'Ivoire, western Africa, approximately 250km north west of the commercial capital Abidjan. The nearest administrative town is Hiré, which is approximately 17km by road from the project.

Bonikro is expected to produce approximately 120koz of gold per annum from 2.4 million tonnes of ore per annum, over a mine life of eight years.

The predominant method of gold recovery is via carbon in leach (CIL) technology, with some gold recovered via a gravity circuit.

Scope of Work

- Procurement, supply and delivery of labour and materials from overseas and locally.
- Installation of electrical instrumentation and commissioning including installation of JV and MV cabling and cable management systems.
- Construction management.
