Project Overview

ECM was awarded the rail infrastructure works for the GE Rail Project, located in Port Hedland, Western Australia.

The rail duplication project extends from Fortescue Metals Group's Solomon Hub to its Christmas Creek site and onto the port in Port Hedland.

The signalling system was the first of its kind in the Pilbara, using satellite positioning technology to track train movements on a 294km stretch of railway. It enabled greater efficiency and flexibility on the track, significantly increasing annual tonnage capacity.
